Description

Anthony Carbonetti was appointed Chief of Staff in 1999 with responsibilities for oversight of scheduling, correspondence, special events, and citywide services in the Mayor's Office and also as advisor to the Mayor on personal, legal, and policy issues. The accession consists of correspondence, memoranda, notes, reports, resumes, and printed material. The accession contains material utilized to make appointments to the administration, research issues of interest to the Mayor and track day to day operations. The accession contains material maintained from Carbonetti's previous positions under the Chief of Staff as Appointment Director and Deputy. The material was processed by the Winthrop Group and includes an inventory, as well as CD-ROM and microfilm copies. Arranged alphabetically.
