Description

Robert M. Harding was Deputy Mayor for Economic Development and Finance, serving from the beginning of 2000 to the end of the administration. He oversaw the implementation of the industrial, commercial, and taxation policies that affect the economic health and viability of New York City and also oversaw the City's relationship with municipal labor unions. The Deputy Mayor coordinated the efforts toward the attraction, retention, and expansion of domestic and global enterprises in the City. The accession consists of correspondence, memoranda, reports, notes, printed materials, plans, and maps. The chronological correspondence is arranged under "L" for Letters. The material was processed by the Winthrop Group who provided an inventory, as well as CD-ROM and microfilm copies of the records. Arranged alphabetically.

Description

Robert M. Harding was appointed Deputy Mayor for Economic Development and Finance in late 1999 or early 2000 with oversight for the implementation of the industrial, commercial, and taxation policies that affect the economic health and viability of New York City. The accession consists of correspondence, memoranda, reports, notes, press releases, and printed material. It was used by the Deputy Mayor to advise and assist the Mayor regarding policy, planning, and programs. Correspondence is with the Mayor, the Deputy Mayors, other members of the Administration and agency heads. Not all of the cubic foot boxes in the accession were filled to capacity. Arranged alphabetically.

Anthony Carbonetti was appointed Chief of Staff in 1999 with responsibilities for oversight of scheduling, correspondence, special events, and citywide services in the Mayor's Office and also as advisor to the Mayor on personal, legal, and policy issues. The accession consists of correspondence, memoranda, notes, reports, resumes, and printed material. The accession contains material utilized to make appointments to the administration, research issues of interest to the Mayor and track day to day operations. The accession contains material maintained from Carbonetti's previous positions under the Chief of Staff as Appointment Director and Deputy.
